Tree Planting Success

Thank you to everyone who turned up on Saturday 5th February to plant trees in the park on Park Avenue. You were so efficient that by the time the last few volunteers arrived there were no more trees to be planted. We got 12 trees into the ground, staked, and guards fitted in around an hour which is amazing when you think of how long they are going to be there for.

The trees planted were:

- 3 x Field Maple, described by the Woodland Trust as pollution fighter, Autumn stunner and syrup maker. Kinnerton maple syrup may be a legacy we leave to our future villagers! These broad leaf trees support caterpillar and aphids and can live for up to 350 years.
- 3 x Alder, perfect for water heavy areas such as the top area of the park where you can often hear the water running just under the surface.
- 2 x Mountain Ash / Rowan, their Flowers and pollen provide nectar for bees while their Autumn berries are a source of food for our overwintering birds.
- 2 x Paperbark Maple, another wet soil loving tree this maple has a distinctive bark giving it yearround attractiveness.
- 2 x Amelanchier, another decorative tree with delicate blossom in the Spring and red to purplecoloured fruits in the Autumn that are a favourite with birds.

Free Tree for all Welsh households

On a related note, the Welsh government has partnered with the Woodland Trust and recently announced that every household in Wales will be offered a free tree to plant as part of the Government's commitment to tackle climate change. This includes an option to have a tree planted on your behalf if you prefer.

It is planned that the first trees will be available to collect from later in March, initially from one of five regional community hubs that will be established. The Welsh Government aims to set up a further 20 hubs across Wales by October 2022. We are still waiting to hear where the regional hubs will be and will keep you posted as and when locations are announced.

A55 Road Closures

Many of you will be aware of the planned road closure on the A55 which will affect any drivers using the expressway between exits 35 (Dobshill) and 36 (Broughton). Traffic Wales recently announced a programme of works to be carried out for 6 weeks between February 28 and April 8 and this will result in some disruption to traffic along this section.

The works involve the removal of the existing worn out road surface and replacement with an improved surface. The plan is to work 24/7, with partial closure during weekdays, and full closure during the night and at weekends. Work will commence with the westbound carriageway, followed by the eastbound. A diversion route is indicated along the A540 (Dobshill to Penymynnyd) and down the A5104 (Penymynydd to Warren Interchange).

Green Communities Project


We are delighted to make you aware that Higher Kinnerton could soon be a 'hot spot' for native pollinators. Working alongside a landscape management team, our local community can help bring wildlife into our village with abundance. The introduction of tended wildflower areas in our village is key to attract as many pollinators to the area as possible.


The three sites currently in mind are -

- Sandy Lane/ Blantern Road junction
- Llys Derwen open space area
- The Stables Farm field, Main Road

A strip of land on each area would be prepared by the landscape team, removing the top layer of grass soil, turning in soil enrichment and planting native wildflowers and shrubs. The wildflower areas for Sandy Lane/Blantern Road and Llys Derwen are shown on the plans below.
