# **Early Entitlement January 2023**

We are very excited to share the news that Kinnerton Little Acorns will be delivering <u>Early Entitlement from January 2023</u>.

This is a very exciting new addition to our setting and we cannot wait to welcome the children in a couple of months. We are aware that Ysgol Derwen are unable to take Early



Entitlement due to class size and it is a pleasure to be able to offer the Early Entitlement here.

We will be running our Early Entitlement sessions on a Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from 09:00 – 11:30.

If your child has turned or is turning 3 years of age between 1<sup>st</sup> September and 8<sup>th</sup> January 2023 and you would like to apply for Early Entitlement, please see the Flintshire County Council website below for details on how to apply.

Early Entitlement is not to be confused with the Childcare Offer we currently run. Early Entitlement children will be entitled to 10 hours per week of Education hours and 20 hours per week of Childcare.


### Higher Kinnerton Walking Group by Michael Collins

# **Higher Kinnerton Dog Waste Bins**

Following on from previous work within the village to combat dog fouling, Higher Kinnerton Community Council have identified problem areas and worked with Flintshire County Council to install five new dog waste bins. The new bins are located as follows:

- a) On the junction with Kinnerton Lane / Main Road opposite the Royal Oak
- b) Bramley Lane where the footpath across the field from Kinnerton Lane emerges onto Bramley Lane
- c) Bramley Lane at the end of the footpath from Park Avenue
- d) The end of Moor Lane just before Frog Hall / Moorside Cottages
- e) At the beginning of the footpath towards Broughton near to Station Farm House

We hope that this will alleviate issues and encourage dog owners to dispose of their dog's waste responsibly.

In addition, HKCC would like to thank Sophie Browne, who has been checking and refilling the waste bag dispensers we have provided around the village. These are marked by a yellow reflective band. Sophie undertook the task as part of her work towards achieving her Duke of Edinburgh's Award and her work is much appreciated by the Community Council. No doubt residents will have noted that since Sophie finished her task, the dispensers have not been regularly replenished, demonstrating the value of Sophie's hard work.

We are now looking for help with this as it takes 1.5hrs to walk around the village and check each dispenser. Alternatively, we would ask that residents who live nearby to the dispenser locations check and advise us if they have run out. HKCC can then make arrangements to replace the waste bags.

### **Higher Kinnerton Biodiversity news**

Earlier this year the Welsh government announced plans to promote a National Forest for Wales, in collaboration with Coed Cadw, and as part of this pledged to provide every household with a tree to plant, free of charge. The trees will help to tackle the effects of climate change.



They have recently set up 50 tree collection hubs across the country and householders are invited to visit one near them to collect their tree sapling, free of charge. There are a number of hubs in our region, as shown on the map. Trees are available now, until December 19th, and again in February and March next year. Full instructions for collecting your tree are on

the website. Alternatively arrangements can be made to post a tree to you. The hubs are able to offer tree planting and care advice. If you are unable to plant a tree in your own garden then a tree can be planted on your behalf. There is a choice of native broad leaf trees, subject to availability

We would encourage all householders in Higher Kinnerton to take part in this initiative as climate change is a global issue which is affecting us all. Trees also provide important habitats for all manner of wildlife such as birds, insects and animals.
