Fundraising Race Night

Kinnerton Scouts and the Village Hall are getting together again to run a fundraising Race Night. It is quite a while since we have had a Race Night (thank you Covid). It will take place on **Saturday 18 November** at 7.30 (for 8). The format will be the same as previously, but if you have never been to a similar event let me explain.

The races are specially filmed for a Race Night, and you can bet on each race of 8 horses. Each bet is £1 and you can bet on as many horses as you want. If your horse wins, you get your winnings.

To make the evening more interesting you can become a race horse owner for only £2. You can also name your horse on the racecard. The owner of the winning horse also receives a prize. You can buy your horse in advance.

We will also run a Tote Double during the night. This involves picking the winners of two races, but this will all be explained on the night.
