2025 season has been a mixture. Playing in Division 2 of the Chester Midweek League was our highest ever standard but we were not quite good enough to stay in the division. The level is very very competitive but we gave an excellent account of ourselves and intend to be back there in 2027.

The plus side was Hayden Millington. Hayden and his father Robert joined the Club last season when they moved to the village and have become enthusiastic team mates.

Hayden who is 15 and attends Castell Alun year 11 started playing cricket around the age of 8 and has represented Mold throughout all the age groups. He made his 1st team debut this year and took 3 wickets. He is on the North Wales development pathway.

When playing for Kinnerton he has been fantastic - he has quickly become our opening batsman and bowler. At end of season awards he was voted both the Player of the Season and the Player's Player of the Season.

But better than that, he was voted the Division 2 Player of the Season by all the other clubs in our division, a considerable feat considering we were relegated and he did not feature in all our matches and is the youngest to have award in the League's 63 year history.

He was presented with his trophy at the League Presentation Evening by England

and Leicestershire fast bowler Jonathon Agnew (Aggers) who is now the voice of Test Match cricket.



Flintshire Digital Support Squad

Flintshire County Council are currently offering residents the opportunity to attend Digital Support drop-in sessions in the locality. Their recently established Digital Support Squad is an innovative approach to digital inclusion,

an initiative which offers **free**, face-to-face support, helping residents navigate the complexities of the digital world with confidence. This could be, for example

- · accessing the internet or email
- keeping in touch with family and friends
- · learning about things that interest them
- supporting friends, family or neighbours who are less digitally savvy
- or, indeed, anything else digital

The Flintshire Digital Support Squad are happy to help and are currently running a number of free drop-in sessions in Flintshire. The drop-in dates for November and December:

- Thursday 13 November 2025 Holywell Connects 10am-12pm
- Wednesday 26 November 2025 Flint Town Hall 10am-12pm
- Tuesday 9 December 2025 Connah's Quay Connects 10am-12pm
- Wednesday 17 December 2025 Flint Town Hall 10am-12pm

If you think one of these might help with a problem or improve your digital skills why not go along. **There is no need to book** - just bring your own device to one of their digital drop ins and the squad will do the rest.



Kinnerton Little Acorns | Early Entitlement (and Playgroup) Spaces

In January 2026, we are about to enter our fourth year of providing Early Entitlement education to children who attend our Little Acorns Playgroup.

Our Early Entitlement sessions are combined into our Playgroup sessions, the only difference is the funding availability. Children who turn 3 on or before the 31st December 2025 will be entitled to 10 hours per week of Early Entitlement education hours from Flintshire County Council. Early Entitlement hours are for all children with the qualifying age noted here. (There will be a further intake for children who turn 3 on or before the 31st March 2026 for our Summer term.) The sessions are full of fun, education and learning (both indoors and outdoors) and they allow children to get used to the routine of a more structured morning so they transition into the school nursery class with ease from September 2026.

Our Early Entitlement sessions run from 9am – 11:25am, Monday to Friday during term time only (in line with Ysgol Derwen).

We also have spaces in our Wraparound sessions which follow the Early Entitlement/Playgroup sessions and run 11:30am – 3pm and we welcome children aged 3 and over. The wraparound sessions are eligible to be funded by the Childcare offer where you may be eligible for an additional 20 hours of childcare funding per week. We also accept payments via BACS, childcare vouchers etc. More information on eligibility is on the link below:
